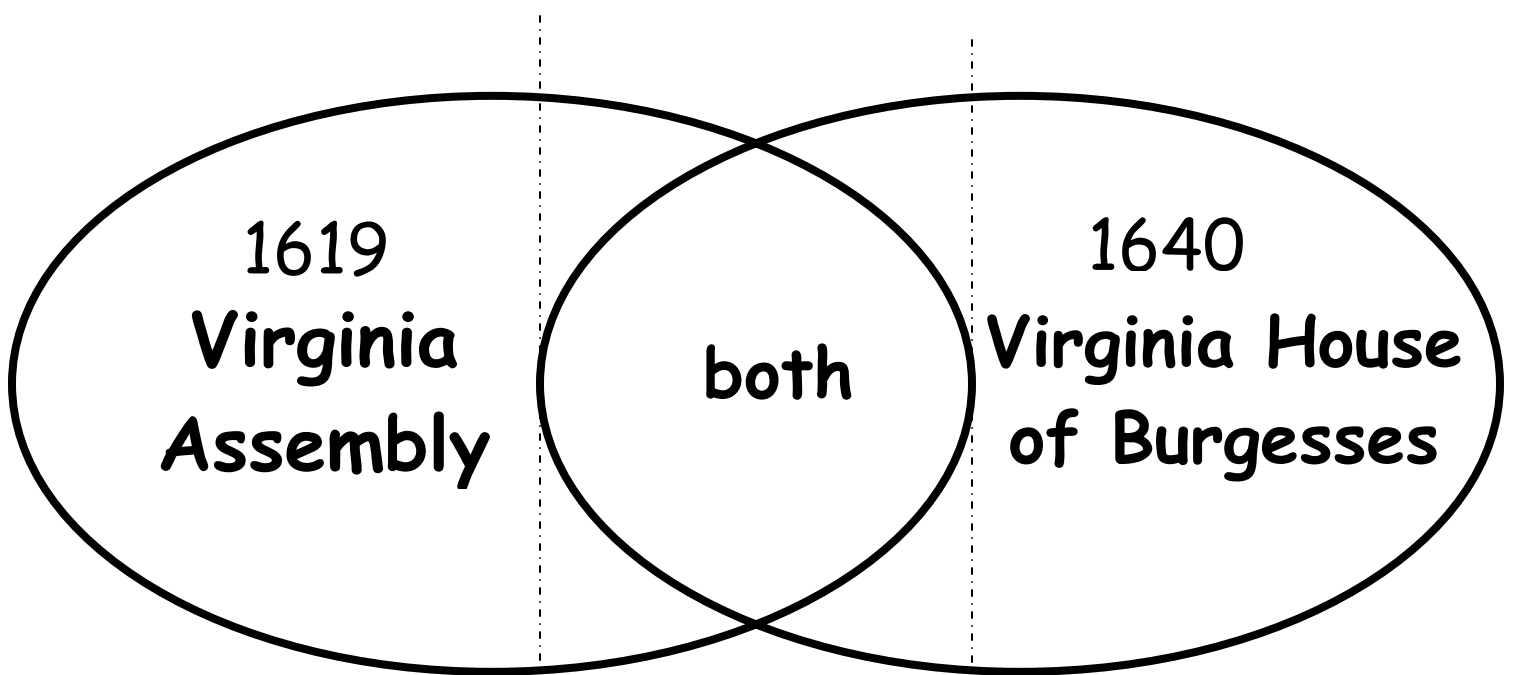


Compare and Contrast Early Government



Teaching Tips: fold a colorful piece of 8 1/2" x 11" paper, hamburger fold, leaving a 1 1/2" tab at the bottom. Glue title "compare and contrast early government" to the tab of the foldable. Glue Venn diagram to the top layer. Cut in top layer in three sections as marked with dotted lines. Use the word bank below and have students cut out and glue the words under the flaps in the correct section to indicate Virginia Assembly in 1619, or the Virginia House of Burgesses in 1640, or both. For some students, it may be best to have them use the word bank and write the words rather than having them cut and glue. Refer to the *Curriculum Framework*, page 12 for details.
