

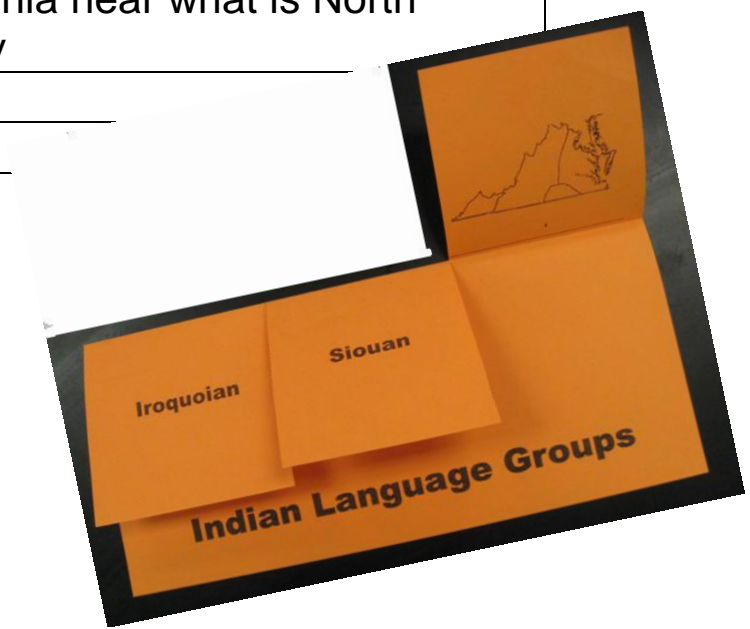
VS.2d Indian Language Groups of Native Peoples

Directions:

- Copy the template below, front to back, onto 8 ½ x 11” white or colored paper so that the title “Indian Language Groups” is at the top, upside down, and the 3 languages are on the reverse side, at the bottom of the page.
- Students fold the three language group names over and crease, hotdog fold, but creasing off center, leaving a tab, so that the title “Indian Language Groups” can be seen.
- Cut on the dotted lines between the language group names, creating 3 tabs.
- Lift each tab and write the tribes and locations underneath. Color or shade the correct region in the mini-map to show the locations on a map.
