

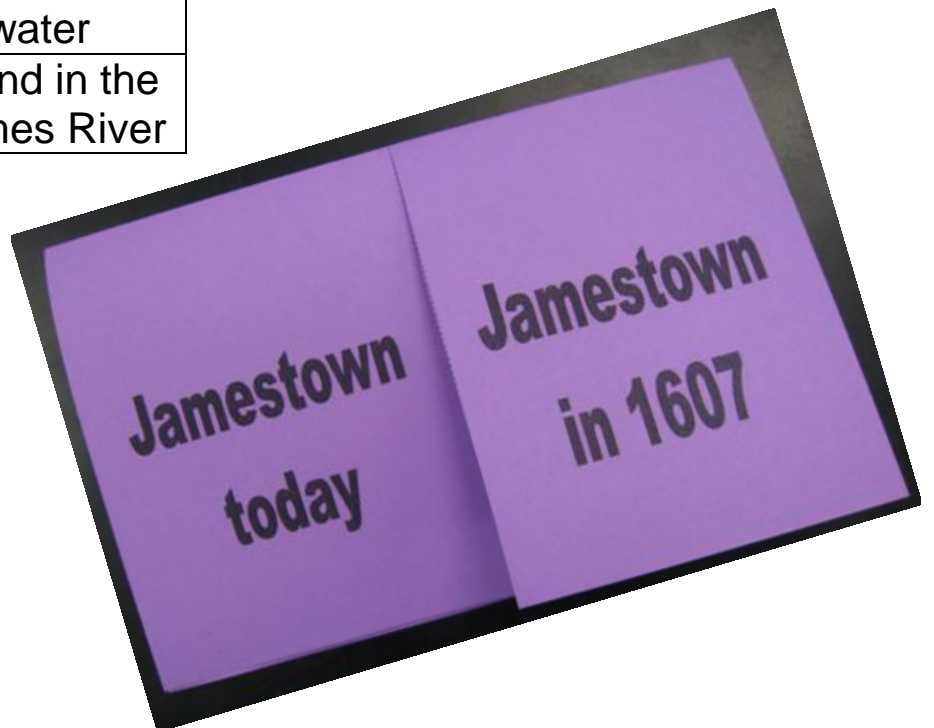
## VS.3.b Jamestown – Island Today and Peninsula in 1607

### Directions:

- Copy the template below onto an 8 ½ x 11” white or colored piece of paper.
- Students make a hamburger fold so that the words “Jamestown today” and “Jamestown in 1607” are showing on top and can be seen.
- Cut on the dotted line between “Jamestown today” and “Jamestown in 1607”, creating 2 tabs.
- Lift each tab. Underneath each tab, write a description about the landform that matches “Jamestown today” and “Jamestown in 1607”.
- Add a drawing to show the landforms.

### Answer Key:

<b>Jamestown 1607</b>	Peninsula Bordered on three sides by water
<b>Jamestown today</b>	Island in the James River
