

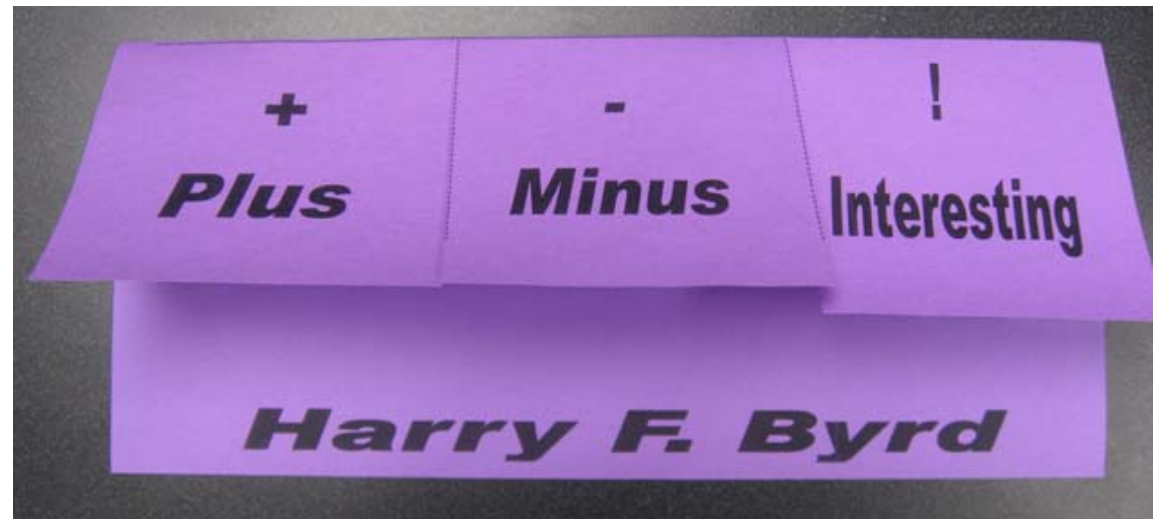
VS.9 c and d - Harry F. Byrd

Directions:

- Copy the template below, front to back, onto 8 ½ x 11” white or colored paper so that the title “Harry F. Byrd” is at the top, upside down, and the words **plus, minus, and interesting** are on the reverse side, at the bottom of the page.
- Students fold the three terms (**plus, minus, and interesting**) over and crease, hotdog fold, but creasing off center, leaving a tab, so that the title “Harry F. Byrd” can be seen.
- Cut on the dotted lines between the 3 words, creating 3 tabs.
- Lift each tab and write how each word applies to Harry F. Byrd underneath.

Answer Key:

Plus +	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• He was governor of Virginia. He was known for his “<u>pay as you go</u>” policy to improve roads.• Harry Byrd modernized state government.
Minus -	In response to The Supreme Court ruling in Brown vs. the Board of Education, he established a policy of <u>Massive Resistance</u> . This delayed integration in Virginia’s schools.
Interesting	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• He was publisher of the <i>Winchester Star</i> newspaper.• Harry Byrd had apple and peach orchards.
